

Artificial Sun – Revolutionizing Clean Energy

By copying the physics of giant stars like our sun, nuclear fusion reactors merge atomic nuclei to create energy in massive amounts, which may then be turned into electricity. Essentially - the end to all our energy woes!

The goal is to deliver endless supply of clean energy by imitating similar reactions that take place in stars like our sun.

Scientists believe nuclear fusion could help humans maximize clean energy production. But the development of such tech is extremely difficult.

In the absence of fossil fuels and toxic waste, nuclear fusion is cleaner and more environmentally friendly than our current methods.

China's "artificial sun" project has sustained a nuclear fusion reaction for more than 17 minutes superheated plasma reached 126 million degrees Fahrenheit—that's roughly five times hotter than the sun.

CYBER SECURITY TIPS

What is cybercrime? Cybercrime is criminal activity that either targets or uses a computer, a computer network or a networked device. Most cybercrime is committed by cybercriminals to make money,damage computers or networks for reasons other than profit which could be political or personal. Some cybercriminals use advanced techniques who are highly technically skilled, others may be novice hackers. Cybercrime involves the following:

• Criminal activity targeting computers using viruses and other types of malware. Cybercriminals that target computers may infect them with malware to damage devices or stop them working. They may also use malware to delete or steal data, stop users from using a website or network.

Criminal activity using computers to commit other crimes.

• Cybercrime that uses computers to commit other crimes may involve using computers or networks to spread malware, illegal information or illegal images.

• Cybercriminals are often doing both at once. Cybercrime may target computers with viruses first and then use them to spread malware to other machines or throughout a network. What are the types of cybercrime? Types of cybercrime include:

• Email and internet fraud, Identity fraud, Theft of financial or card payment data, Theft and sale of corporate data, Cyberextortion, Ransomware attacks, Cryptojacking, Cyberespionage, Interfering with systems in a way that compromises a network, Infringing copyright, Illegal gambling, Selling illegal items online, Soliciting, producing, or possessing child pornography.
